

Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire Historic Churches Trust (BHHCT) awards grants to churches and chapels to help with the cost of repair and restoration. Many of these buildings are of outstanding historic importance and all are loved and used. The Trust helps to preserve these buildings so that they remain active centres of community life.

Church buildings matter to local people because of history, architectural beauty, spiritual value, and their role in a community. A church may be the only public building where people can meet.

Since the Trust was formed in 1991, it has awarded nearly £4 million to help churches in Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire, and part of Barnet. The money comes from: donations; legacies; subscriptions and the sponsored Bike 'n Hike on the second Saturday of September.
