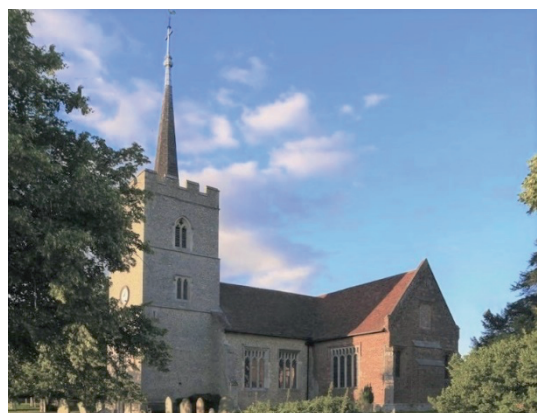

<p><b>Northamptonshire</b> <b>Saturday, 11 June</b> Led by Bob Sharpe</p> <p>Meet at Northampton Railway Station at 9.00am</p> <p><b>Programme</b> <b>St Peter's, Northampton</b> (Churches Conservation Trust) – "one of the most exceptional Norman churches in the country". <b>Holy Sepulchre, Northampton</b> – "A Norman round church - a rarity in any country". <b>Lunch at Earls Barton.</b> <b>All Saints', Earls Barton</b> – "The late Anglo-Saxon tower is a mighty piece". <b>All Saints', Brixworth</b> – "One of the grandest examples of Anglo-Saxon architecture in England – one might even say Europe". <b>Tea at Brixworth.</b> Return to Northampton Station for 6.00pm.</p> <p>Quotations from "The Buildings of England" books.</p>	<p><b>East Hertfordshire</b> <b>Saturday, 17 September</b> Led by William Marsterson</p> <p>Meet at Ware Railway Station at 10.00am</p> <p><b>Programme</b> <b>St John the Baptist, Great Amwell</b> - "A small church of great antiquity distinguished by its Norman apse." <b>St James, Stanstead Abbots</b> (Churches Conservation Trust)- "Few churches have so well preserved an C18th village character." <b>Lunch</b> <b>St Dunstan, Hunsdon</b> – Tudor and later additions include a sumptuous Jacobean screen and good monuments <b>St Andrew, Much Hadham</b> – Visually probably the best village in the county. <b>St Mary, Ware</b> – A typical Herts town church – "Very large, very handsome." (Sir John Betjeman) <b>Tea</b> and return to Ware railway station.</p>
