A beautiful, historic church

The medieval Parish Church of St Mary lies at the heart of Ware. It has a wonderful performance space which is perfect for concerts.

Finding St Mary's

St Mary's address is High Street, Ware, SG12 9EH. The church is set back at the west end of the High Street, opposite Ware Priory and the town museum. See the map on the church's webpage <https://www.achurchnearyou.com/church/7901/find-us/>.

Public transport and car parking

St Mary's is 10 minutes' walk from Ware Railway Station which is to its south-east.

There is 3 hours free car parking at Tesco, which is a 5 minute walk away (postcode SG12 7BU).

Burgage Lane pay and display car park is just over the other side of the High Street to the church, again a 5 minute walk away (postcode SG12 9XF).

Baldock Street pay and display car park is on the same side of the High Street, but a little further away (postcode SG12 9DT).

Access

There is very limited space for parking at the church. This should be kept free for those with limited mobility and to allow offloading of equipment etc. The car park is accessed from Church Street, a one-way street running behind the High Street. The entrance to Church Street is just by the shop 'Honey Nails'.

There is level access from the South Porch and at both entrances via the Hall, and a ramp into the Lady Chapel. There are accessible toilets. Please say if you have any other special access needs.
